SUPPLY OPPORTUNITIES

There will be many opportunities for local businesses of all types and sizes to be involved.

If our projects are approved and proceed to construction, we'll procure around 10 major contracts for components and activities, including wind turbines, cables and marine installation.

Downstream opportunities through the successful contractors are expected to include civil and electrical works, geotechnical investigations, labour hire, consulting services, transport, health and safety training, waste disposal services, catering and more.

There will also be long-term opportunities over the project's 30-year operational life.

We're committed to supporting local suppliers to participate in, grow with, and maximise opportunities created in Australia's new offshore wind industry. This includes supporting Aboriginal owned businesses and social enterprises.

LOCAL FIRST

Offshore wind will bring a new wave of industry and opportunity to Gippsland.

Gippsland has played a key role in Victoria's electricity industry for decades, supported by an established supply chain and skilled workforce.

Many local businesses already have the capability needed to support the offshore wind industry.

Our Local First approach prioritises working with Gippsland suppliers when procuring goods and services. We expect our contractors to do the same.
